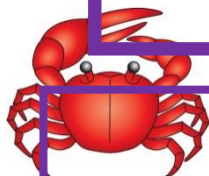
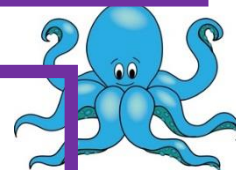
Expressive Arts and Design
